ORGANIC WASTE



Food scraps (cooked and raw), fish, meat, bones, coffee grounds, tea bags, paper tissues and napkins (even if greasy), greasy paper, compostable cutlery and tableware, compostable shopping bags, ash residues



Wet wipes, cigarette butts



Never use non-compostable plastic bags.

LIGHT MULTI-MATERIALS



Plastic bottles, detergent and shampoo containers, aluminum cans and metal tins, caps and lids made of tin, metal or plastic, Tetra Pak beverage cartons, aluminum foil, plastic bags, single-use plastic plates and cups, tubes for toothpaste, preserves and creams, plastic and polystyrene food trays, plastic and metal hangers sold with clothing



Any items that are not packaging, plastic objects, biodegradable and compostable plastic

PAPER AND CARDBOARD



Scrap paper, newspapers, books and notebooks, paper bags, cardboard packaging, pizza boxes



Laminated paper, baking paper, receipts, waxed paper, aluminum foil, Tetra Pak and other composite materials



Always flatten cardboard packaging. Do not use plastic bags. Do not leave materials outside the bin when it's raining.

GLASS



Bottles, jars, flasks, glass containers



Crystal (e.g. drinking glasses), ceramics (e.g. coffee cups), porcelain (e.g. plates), light bulbs, neon tubes and other electronic waste, mirrors and flat glass sheets, demijohns, Pyrex dishes



Caps and lids must be separated from the glass container: you can dispose of plastic and metal in the mixed recycling, and cork in the organic waste.

NON-RECYCLABLE WASTE

- ✓ Laminated paper, CDs, DVDs and VHS tapes, ceramics, porcelain and crystal, cosmetics and cotton swabs, small rigid plastic items, razor blades, adhesive and abrasive tape, pens and markers, X-rays, photographic film and printed photos, vacuum cleaner bags, toothbrushes, sponges, cigarette butts, plastic and metal cutlery
- ✗ Anything that can be disposed of through separate collection (recyclable waste)

GREEN WASTE, GRASS CLIPPINGS AND PRUNINGS

ASCIT SpA organizes the collection of your grass clippings, leaves, and small pruning residues. DIAPERS AND INCONTINENCE PADS

- ✓ Diapers and bed pads for children, incontinence pads and bed pads for adults
- ✗ Absorbent pads for animals, other absorbent materials
- * In municipalities with a Pay-As-You-Throw system (where waste bills are calculated based on the number of grey bags with RFID tags), it is possible to dispose of sanitary pads in the purple bag provided by the waste collection service, so that they are excluded from the billing calculation.

COLLECTION CENTERS

All materials that, due to volume, weight, or type, cannot be disposed of through door-to-door collection must be taken to the Collection Center. **Check the location of your municipality's center on www.ascit.it or consult the collection calendar.**

Materials contained in black bags, small hardware, and construction and demolition waste—such as rock wool, bituminous membranes, drywall, and fiberglass roofing sheets—are not accepted (please contact Ascit for these materials).
